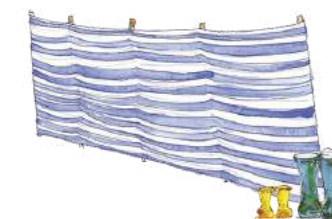

From freshly made breakfasts to traditional afternoon teas, it's the perfect spot to refuel after a long walk on the beach – dog's are welcome too!





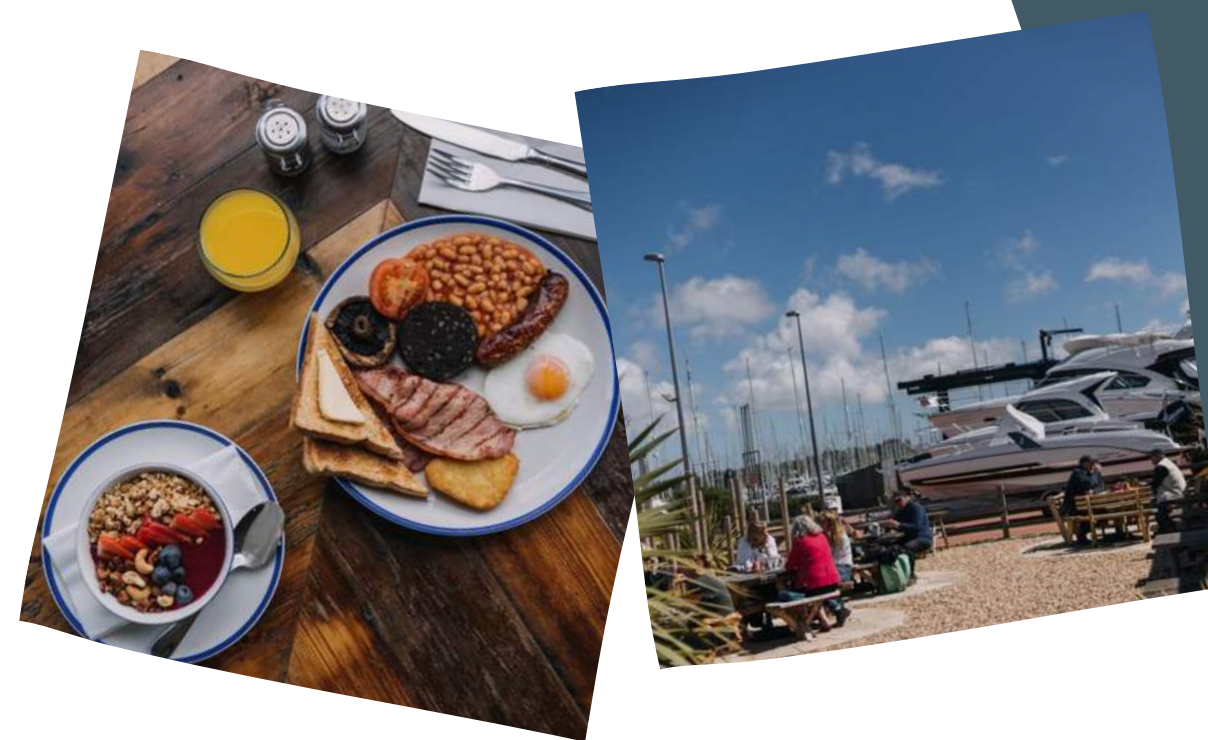

There are numerous local supermarket chains in the Witterings.

Tesco Express and the Co-op can be found on the parade in East Wittering, and all of the big boys will deliver to your door however, the area also boasts a number of local fresh food shops.



## Cooking In and buying fresh

We recommend Horrocks or Munneries in East Wittering for your fresh fruit and vegetables.

Local butchers AS Wallace in East Wittering and Tessiers in West Wittering are both excellent for fresh and cooked meat and pies.

We also highly recommend a stroll down to the bottom of Shore Road where you will find Bob in his “Fisherman’s Hut”. He is normally there between 11am and 4pm but it depends on the available catch. All his fish is freshly caught so get there early to get the best he has to offer.

If it's baked goods you're after, Knead is a must visit. A trendy artisan bakery in East Wittering village serving freshly baked bread and sweet treats. Grab a coffee and croissant whilst you're visiting too!

The National Trust's East Head at the end of West Wittering beach is a gorgeous place to walk and enjoy the wildlife in the sand dunes (note; car parking must be booked in advance via [JustPark](#)). The nature reserve at RSPB Pagham Harbour and the mudflats at RSPB Medmerry in Sidlesham ([rspb.org.uk](#)) offer lovely walking and cycling. The Selsey Blue Plaque Heritage Trail ([mwhg.org.uk](#)) comprises three self-guided walks that explore the Blue Plaques in and around Selsey.

Further afield, the Windmill Trail ([boxgrovepc.org](#)) starts at Boxgrove Village Hall carpark and ends at Halnaker Windmill.

# Dogs on the Beach

*the do's and don't's*

West Wittering beach is very popular with dog walkers throughout the year although there are restrictions on where dogs can go on the beach between 1st May and 30th September.

Dogs are not allowed on the beach at all between groynes numbered 14a to 18, which is the area in front of the line of beach huts. You can walk dogs on a lead through the car park to access East Head, which is dog friendly all year around.

Dogs are also free to walk on the rest of the beach but you are requested to keep them on a lead on the stretch in front of Shore Road in East Wittering and again in front of the car park at Bracklesham Bay.

Don't forget, if you're going to West Wittering beach, car parking must be booked in advance via the [JustPark](#) app.

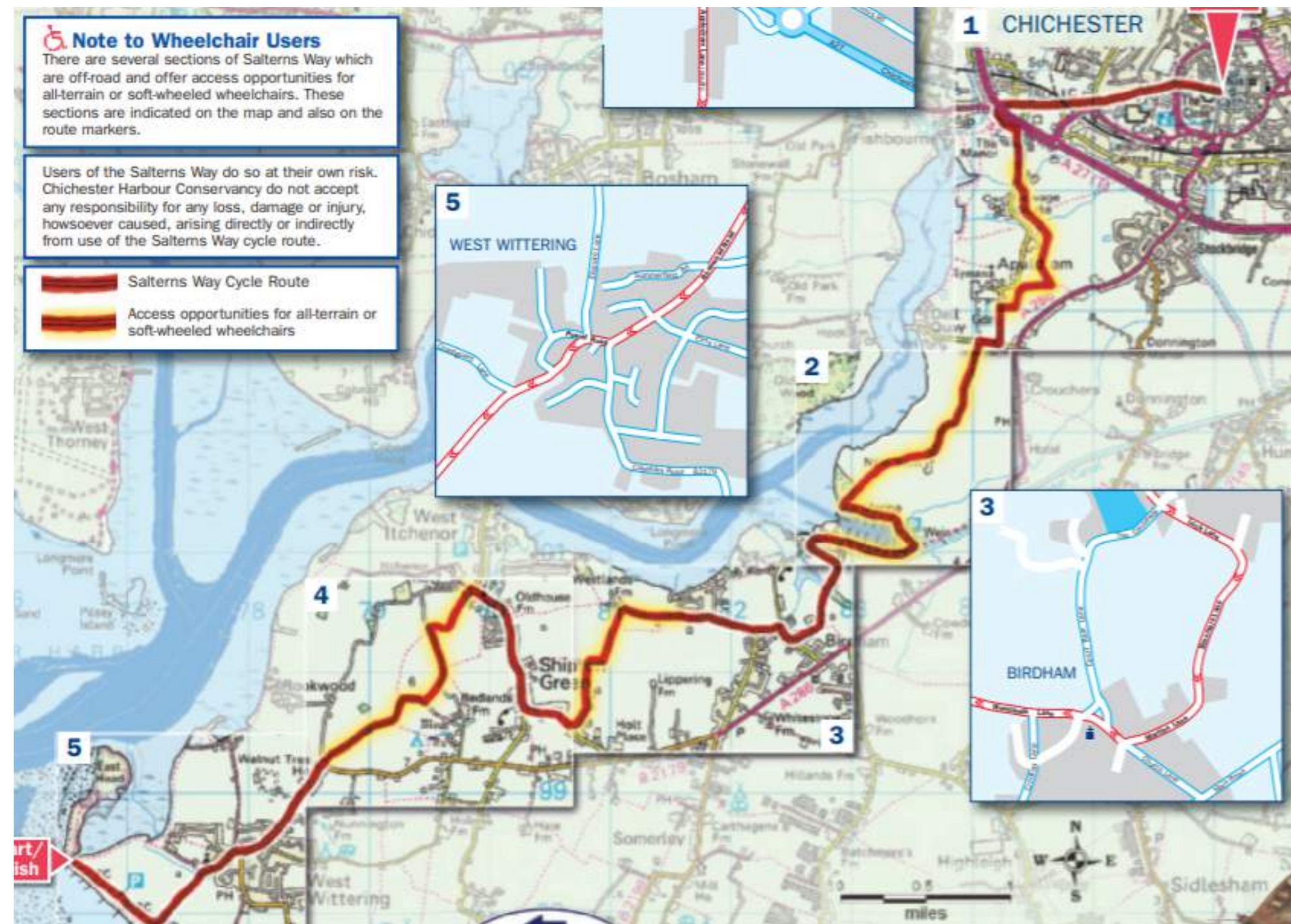
